

BSC Level 1 Certificate in Health and Safety at Work

A young person is seriously injured in a UK workplace every 40 minutes. In the last decade, 66-under 19s have been killed at work.

How it works

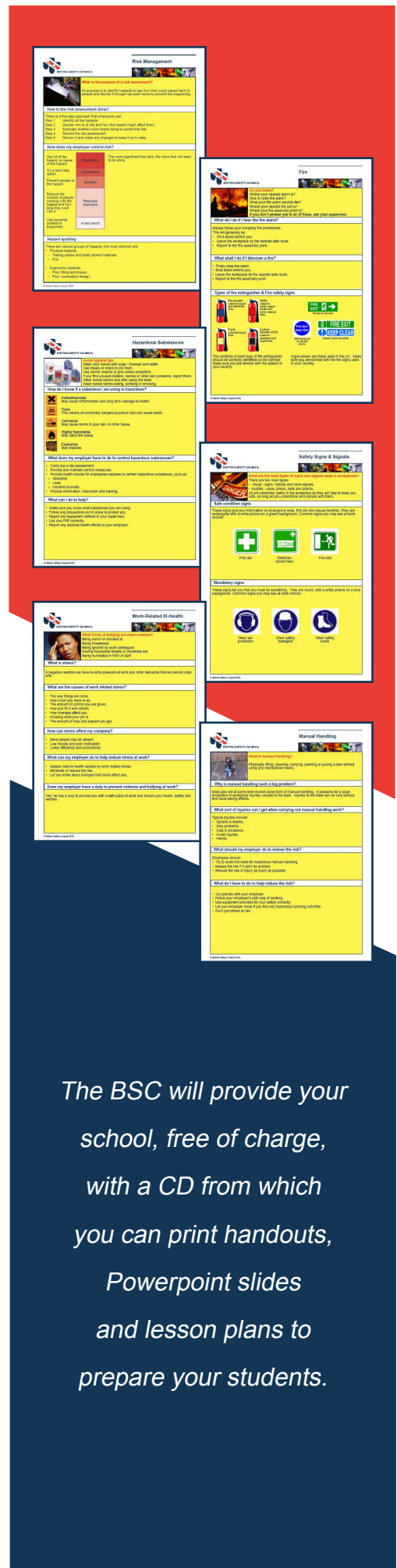
- Register now by telephoning BSC Examinations on 020 8600 1034 or e-mailing schools@britsafe.org
- Become a member of the British Safety Council at the special schools rate of £150 (normally £350)
- Prepare your students for the 40-question multiple choice examination using the free learning materials supplied by the BSC
- Order unlimited examinations at £5 per candidate (normally £10)
- Invigilate the examinations and return the answer forms for marking
- Receive results and qualification certificates within five working days
