Course Aims

This one day introductory programme is aimed at people in the construction industry who want to develop their understanding of environmental issues in the workplace. For many people in the construction industry, some environmental issues seem remote when compared to their day-to-day activities. Priority tends to be given to those areas that are subject to direct regulation or are the cause of complaint among the local community.

This course has a particular focus on your construction site or project and allows you to identify the key environmental issues on your site, what the legal obligations are and how environmental improvements can be made.
