Professor Dame Carol Black DBE, FRCP, FMedSci is Principal of Newnham College Cambridge, Expert Adviser on Health and Work, Public Health England and Expert Adviser to NHS England on the Health and Wellbeing of NHS Staff, and Chairman of the Nuffield Trust for Research and Policy Studies in Health Services. She is also a member of the Welsh Government's Bevan Commission on health in Wales. Is currently completing for the Prime Minister an independent review of the impact on employment and the benefits system of addiction to drugs or alcohol or obesity.

In November 2011 when National Director for Health and Work she completed as Co-Chair an independent review for the UK Government of sickness absence in Britain. The recommendations of this report are now being put in place, with for example a national Fit for Work Service.
