Paul Almond is a Professor of Law at the University of Reading. His research interests lie in the fields of criminal law, regulation, criminology, and health and safety law. Paul has published widely on these issues, including a book, 'Corporate Manslaughter and Regulatory Reform' (Palgrave Macmillan, 2013), ESRC-funded research into public perceptions of work-related death, and ground-breaking work on the political and media context of health and safety policymaking in the UK.

More recently, he completed (with Dr Mike Esbester, University of Portsmouth) an IOSH-funded research project on 'The Changing Legitimacy of Health and Safety Regulation, 1960-2015' (www.iosh.co.uk/changinglegitimacy).

Paul is currently working with the International Labour Organization (ILO) on a project looking at health and safety enforcement and sanctioning regimes.
