Why is this qualification important?

Environmental resources are limited and are sensitive to many of the things we do. The actions we take today will affect things in the future. This qualification raises awareness of sustainability issues and helps learners to make sustainable choices.

Qualification content

Assessment

- Pass mark 20 out of 30.

How it works

- Centres order the examination for a date and time of their choosing
- Examinations are available online or paper-based
- Results of online examinations issued immediately to centres
- Results of paper-based examinations issued within two to five working days
- Certificates issued within two to five working days.
