## Recognition of Prior Learning Policy



### **What is recognition of prior learning?**

Recognition of prior learning is recognition by an awarding organisation of any learning undertaken and/or attainment by a learner that fully meets the assessment requirements for one or more units in a qualification. This allows the awarding organisation to exempt the learner from those units.

### **British Safety Council policy**

Due to the specific assessment requirements of British Safety Council qualifications, it is unlikely that any previous learning undertaken and/or attainment by a learner will fully meet the assessment requirements for one or more units within a British Safety Council qualification. On this basis, the British Safety Council does not normally grant exemptions.
